From Bill – “This is one of the Elite Racing Series runs. Not a bad course with a few hills but not hard ones. It starts in Rancho Simi Park and all 13.1 miles are run on a bike path along the Arroyo Creek (which actually has flowing water). About half of the course is tree lined, which helps a lot as it can get warm early in Simi Valley this time of year. The turnout was small in all three races, mostly because the date for this race has been moved around. The race director said June will be its permanent home and hopefully that will get it back to the 600+ runners it used to have three years ago.”
